

The forecast is based on the current depth at the port and the latest long term water level forecast issued by INA (National Water Institute). INA draws information from multiple sources for it's forecasts. Due to the present extreme low levels changes can be sudden and occur over short periods of time, such as rainfall, opening/closure of dams and weather induced tidal surges in the River Plate. The report is refreshed on a weekly basis and will always be subject to some level of deviation. The outlook is still critical and trends will be reported closely to better forecast short and medium term outlooks.
